3. Institutional Strengthening and Development

We enhance the capacity of government departments, non-state actors, and MIDRIFT staff to collectively advance Peace, Good Governance, and Human Rights. Through targeted training, policy support, and organizational development, we empower institutions and non-state actors to foster a culture of Peace and Security, Good governance and Human Rights.
